### North Korean hackers steal military secrets for weapons programme: US, allies

London. North Korean hackers have conducted a global cyber espionage campaign to try to steal classified military secrets to support Pyongyang's banned nuclear weapons programme, the United States, Britain and South Korea said in a joint advisory on Thursday. The hackers, dubbed Anadriel or APT45 by cybersecurity researchers, have targeted or breached computer systems at a broad variety of defence or engineering firms, including manufacturers of tanks, submarines, naval vessels, fighter aircraft, and missile and radar systems, the advisory said. "The authoring agencies believe the group and the cyber techniques remain an ongoing threat to various industry sectors worldwide, including but not limited to entities in their respective countries, as well as in Japan and India", the advisory said. It was co-authored by the US Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), the US National Security Agency (NSA) and cyber agencies, Britain's National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC), and South Korea's National Intelligence Service (NIS).

"The global cyber espionage operation that we have exposed today shows the lengths that DPRK state-sponsored actors are willing to go to pursue their military and nuclear programmes," said Paul Chichester at the NCSC, a part of Britain's GCHQ spy agency.

Internationally isolated North Korea, or the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK), has a long history of using covert hacking teams to steal sensitive military information. In August last year, Reuters exclusively reported that one elite group of North Korean hackers had successfully breached systems at NPO Mashinostroyeniya, a rocket design bureau based in Reutov, a small town on the outskirts of Moscow. As was the case with that hack, APT45 - a part of North Korea's Reconnaissance General Bureau intelligence agency - used common phishing techniques and computer exploits to trick officials at the firms they were targeting into giving away access to their internal computer systems, Thursday's advisory said.

### Mexican drug lord 'El Mayo', leader of Sinaloa cartel, arrested in US

UPDATED. Mexican drug lord Ismael "El Mayo" Zambada and the son of his former partner, Joaquin "El Chapo" Guzman, were arrested in El Paso, Texas, on Thursday, the US Justice Department said. "The Justice Department has taken into custody two additional alleged leaders of the Sinaloa Cartel, one of the most violent and powerful drug trafficking organizations in the world," the department said in a statement. Zambada and Joaquin Guzman Lopez, the son of El Chapo, face multiple charges in the US "for heading the Cartel's criminal operations, including its deadly fentanyl manufacturing and trafficking networks," the statement said. The arrest of Guzman Lopez was first reported by Reuters, ahead of the Justice Department statement. Two U.S. officials told Reuters that Zambada and Guzman Lopez were detained after landing in a private plane. Zambada is one of the most consequential traffickers in Mexico's history and co-founded the Sinaloa Cartel with El Chapo, who was extradited to the United States in 2017 and is serving a life sentence in a maximum security prison.

After El Chapo's extradition, his criminal empire was inherited by four of his sons -- known as Los Chapitos, or Little Chapos -- who took over his faction of the cartel and became some of the biggest exporters of fentanyl to the United States. El Mayo and Los Chapitos have had a fractious relationship since El Chapo's extradition, and the arrests of the two traffickers may trigger instability or even violence in Mexico. US federal prosecutors in February charged Zambada with conspiracy to manufacture and distribute fentanyl, which the Drug Enforcement Administration says is the leading cause of death for Americans between the ages of 18 and 45.

### Nearly 300,000 displaced in eastern China as Typhoon Gaemi hits

World. Authorities evacuated nearly 300,000 people and suspended public transport across eastern China on Friday due to Typhoon Gaemi, which brought torrential rains that have already caused five deaths in Taiwan. Gaemi, the strongest typhoon to hit Taiwan in eight years, made landfall on Thursday, flooding parts of the island's second largest city. Typhoon also intensified seasonal rains in the Philippines on its way to Taiwan, triggering floods and landslides that resulted in 20 deaths. A tanker carrying 1.4 million liters of oil sank off Manila due to the severe weather conditions, prompting authorities to act swiftly to contain a potential fuel spill. By the time Typhoon Gaemi reached China's eastern Fujian province shortly before 8:00pm local time (1200 GMT) on Thursday, it had already weakened, according to state media. China has been experiencing a summer of extreme weather. Heavy rains have lashed the eastern and southern parts of the country, while the northern regions have faced successive heatwaves. These conditions are believed to be exacerbated by climate change, with China being the largest emitter of greenhouse gases. Chinese authorities warned that Typhoon Gaemi would bring torrential rains capable of causing significant flooding. More than 290,000 people were relocated in Fujian province, and public transport, offices, schools, and markets were shut down in various cities to prepare for the storm. In neighboring Zhejiang province, state broadcaster CCTV showed footage on Friday of streets turned into rivers and roads blocked by fallen trees. Bicycles were seen struggling through knee-high waters. Wenzhou city, which has a population of nine million, issued its highest warning for rainstorms and evacuated nearly 7,000 people as a precaution.

State media reported that Typhoon Gaemi would bring heavy rainfall to central Jiangxi and Henan provinces. In Guangdong province, the most populous in China, some passenger train services were suspended on Friday in anticipation of the typhoon's arrival.

CCTV cited the official China Weather Network, saying, that the typhoon was moving northwestward at about 20 kilometers per hour and was expected to "gradually weaken" as it traveled toward Jiangxi by late Friday afternoon. As of now, no deaths or injuries have been reported in China due to the typhoon. However, the northwestern province of Gansu experienced heavy rains this week, resulting in one death and three missing persons.

## Bill introduced in US Congress to strengthen partnership ties with India

Washington. US Senator Marco Rubio on Thursday introduced a bill in the Congress which proposes to treat India on par with its allies like as Japan, Israel, Korea and NATO allies regarding technology transfers, support India in its response to growing threats to its territorial integrity and bar Pakistan from receiving security assistance if it is found to have sponsored terrorism against India. "Communist China continues to aggressively expand its domain in the Indo-Pacific region, all while it seeks to impede the sovereignty and autonomy of our regional partners. It's crucial for the U.S. to continue its support in countering these malicious tactics. India, along with other nations in the region, is not alone," Rubio said after he introduced the U.S.-India Defense Cooperation Act in the Senate. Given the short timeline of a bitterly divided Congress in an election year, the bill is unlikely to make much headway, but might be reintroduced in the next Congress given that there is a bipartisan level of support on India-US

relationship. The bill notes that the US-India partnership is vital to countering influences from Communist China. In order to strengthen this partnership, it is essential to enhance our strategic diplomatic, economic, and military relationship with New Delhi, it asserts.

Among other things, the bill would set a Statement of Policy that the US will support India in its response to growing threats to its territorial integrity, provide necessary security assistance to India to deter adversaries, and cooperate with India with respect to defense, civil space, technology, medicine and economic investments. When passed into law, it would provide a limited exemption for India from CAATSA sanctions for purchases of Russian equipment that are currently used by the Indian military and set a sense of Congress that expeditious consideration of certifications of letters of offer to sell



defense articles, defense services, design and construction services, and major defense equipment to India is consistent with US interests and it is in the interest of peace and stability India to have the capabilities needed to deter threats. It proposes to treat India as if it were of the same status as the US allies such as Japan, Israel, Korea, and NATO allies regarding

technology transfers; authorize the Secretary of State to enter into a memorandum of understanding with India to increase military cooperation; expedite excess defense articles to India for two years and grant India the same status as other allies; and expand International Military Education and Training Cooperation with New Delhi.

It requires a report to Congress on Pakistan's use of offensive force, including through terrorism and proxy groups, against India; and bar Pakistan from receiving security assistance if it is found to have sponsored terrorism against India. This is for the first time such an India-centric bill has been introduced in the US Congress that proposes to put India at the same level of that of its treaty ally, exempt it from CAATSA sanctions, and imposes sanctions on Pakistan for promoting terrorism in India.

## Typhoon Gaemi slams China after Taiwan, thousands evacuated, floods feared

Beijing. Typhoon Gaemi roared into southeastern China on Thursday after churning across the Taiwan Strait, prompting warnings of swelling rivers, flash floods and waterlogging in cities and provinces that were hit by extreme rains just several weeks ago. Gaemi, the third and most powerful typhoon to hit China's eastern seaboard this year, made landfall in Fujian province at 7:50 p.m. (1150 GMT) after whipping Taiwan with gusts of up to 227 kph (141 mph), some of the strongest winds recorded in the Western Pacific Ocean. Despite slightly weakening since its landfall in Fujian's Putian, a city of over 3 million, Gaemi and its giant cloud-bands are forecast to unleash intense rainfall in at least 10 Chinese provinces in the coming days.



The arrival of Gaemi has drawn comparisons with Typhoon Doksuri last year, which triggered historic flooding as far north as Beijing and caused nationwide losses of nearly \$30 billion. Authorities said water levels in the lower reaches of the Yangtze River as well as the vast freshwater lakes of Poyang and Dongting in central China could rise, returning to dangerous levels seen in early July after intense summer rains. Due to its high vapour content, Beijing cautioned that Gaemi could spawn strong rainfall in the Chinese capital, about 2,000 km (1,242 miles) north of Putian, even as the storm weakens into a tropical depression. Gaemi's rains could cause flash floods and waterlogging, particularly in parts of northern China where the soil remains saturated after being lashed by a passing system of storms earlier this week, authorities warned. In Taiwan, Gaemi killed three people, triggered flooding and sank a freighter after the strongest typhoon to hit the island in eight years made landfall on Wednesday night. Some parts of southern Taiwan are expected

to have recorded rainfall of 2,200 mm (87 inches) since Tuesday. The storm cut power to around half a million households, though most are now back online, utility Taipower said.

Apart from the three fatalities, 380 were injured by the typhoon in Taiwan, the government said. Taiwan's fire department said a Tanzania-flagged freighter with nine Myanmar nationals on board had sunk off the coast of the southern port city of Kaohsiung. Three of them have since been found alive on the shoreline, Taiwan's coast guard said. Taiwanese television stations showed pictures of flooded streets in cities and counties across the island. Li Li-chuan, 55, saw the roof of her restaurant blow off in the northeastern Taiwanese city of Suao. "I was frightened," she told Reuters. "It was the strongest in years. I was worried that the roof would hit other people." Offices and schools as well as the financial markets closed for a second day on Thursday, while trains were stopped until 3 p.m. (0700 GMT) and all domestic flights and 195 international flights were cancelled.

## UN rights chief urges probe of Bangladesh protest crackdown

GENEVA. The UN rights chief called Thursday on Bangladesh to urgently disclose the details of last week's crackdown on protests amid accounts of "horrific violence", calling for "an impartial, independent and transparent investigation". "We understand that many people were subjected to violent attacks by groups reportedly affiliated with the Government, and no effort was made to protect them," Volker Turk said in a statement.

protest leaders announced a temporary halt to new demonstrations. Turk's statement lamented reports that



some of the more than 1,000 injured in last week's crackdown were denied medical care, while many people remained missing. "At least two journalists were reportedly killed and scores of others injured. Hundreds of people were also reportedly arrested, including opposition figures," the statement said. The government, it said, "must provide the details of those

killed, injured, or detained for the benefit of their families". The UN high commissioner for human rights also called on the government to restore full internet access to allow people, including journalists, to communicate freely. "Blunt measures such as a blanket deliberate internet shutdown for a prolonged period contravene international law, affecting States' obligations to respect freedom of expression and the right to peaceful assembly," he said.

This also breached "a wide range of other rights, including freedom of association and of movement, the rights to health and education, and a number of economic rights," Turk said.

"Internet shutdowns can also reduce public scrutiny and knowledge of conduct of law enforcement agencies, and so risk heightening impunity for their actions," he warned.

### Joe Biden reiterated in their Oval Office meeting his calls for Israel and Hamas to quickly agree to a cease-fire deal that would bring home the remaining hostages.

Washington. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu visited the White House Thursday to discuss the war in Gaza -- and the possibility of securing a cease-fire deal -- with President Joe Biden and likely Democratic nominee Vice President Kamala Harris. Netanyahu's first White House visit since 2020 comes at a time of growing pressure in Israel and the U.S. to

find an endgame to the nine-month war that's left more than 39,000 dead in Gaza and some 1,200 dead in Israel. Dozens of Israeli hostages are still languishing in Hamas captivity. Biden reiterated in their Oval Office meeting his calls for Israel and Hamas to quickly agree to a cease-fire deal that would bring home the remaining hostages, according to White House national security spokesman John Kirby. White House officials say the negotiations are in the closing stages, but there are issues that need to be resolved. "The gaps are closable," Kirby said. He added, "But it's going to require, as it always does, some leadership, some compromise." Harris is scheduled to meet separately on Thursday with Netanyahu. She is also expected to press him on securing a deal to release the hostages kidnapped during Hamas' Oct. 7 attack on Israel that launched the war.



Netanyahu, last at the White House when former President Donald Trump was in office, is headed to Florida on Friday to meet with the Republican presidential nominee. The conservative Likud Party leader Netanyahu and centrist Democrat Biden have had ups-and-downs over the years. Netanyahu, in what will likely be his last White House meeting with Biden, reflected on the roughly 40 years they've known each other and thanked the president for his service. "From a proud Jewish Zionist to a proud Irish American Zionist, I want to thank you for 50 years of public service and 50 years of support for the state of Israel," Netanyahu told Biden

at the start of their meeting. A U.S.-backed proposal to release remaining hostages in Gaza over three phases is something that would be a legacy-affirming achievement for Biden, who abandoned his reelection bid and endorsed Harris. It could also be a boon for Harris in her bid to succeed him.

Following their talks, Biden and Netanyahu met with the families of American hostages. For Harris, the meeting with Netanyahu is an opportunity to demonstrate that she has the mettle to serve as commander in chief. She's being scrutinized by those on the political left who say Biden hasn't done enough to force Netanyahu to end the war and by Republicans looking to brand her as insufficient in her support for Israel. A senior administration official, who briefed reporters on the condition of anonymity under ground rules set by the White House, said there is "no daylight between the president and vice president.



and we will not tolerate it in our nation," Harris said.

She further slammed the burning of the US flag. "I condemn the burning of the American flag. That flag is a symbol of our highest ideals as a nation and represents the promise of America. It should never be desecrated in that way," she stated.

During Wednesday's protests, prior to the events at Union Station, police used pepper spray on some of the thousands of demonstrators and made several arrests. In her statement, Harris reiterated her support for the right to peaceful protest but added that "Antisemitism, hate, and violence of any kind have no place in our nation." The protests against Netanyahu, however, continued for the second day. After the Capitol, the Gaza war protestors gathered outside the White House and raised slogans against Netanyahu.

As per a report by the news agency Associated Press, the protesters chanted, "Arrest Netanyahu," and brought in an effigy of Netanyahu with blood on its hands and wearing an orange jumpsuit.

Meanwhile, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu met President Joe Biden at the White House on Thursday. Netanyahu is also scheduled to meet with Vice President Kamala Harris later.

## Stolen Indian Artifacts: India, US Sign Cultural Property Agreement To Repatriate

**RNS I New Delhi:** India and the United States have today formalized a Cultural Property Agreement aimed at repatriating stolen Indian artifacts currently held in the US. This landmark agreement marks the first such accord between the two nations.

Under the new agreement, both countries will collaborate to curb and prevent the illicit trade, import, export, and trafficking of archaeological and ethnological materials. The deal is seen as a significant step forward in protecting and preserving cultural heritage. At a press conference in New Delhi, Culture and Tourism Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat hailed the agreement as historic. He emphasized that it would enhance bilateral relations and promote intercultural



growth between the two countries. Shekhawat noted that the agreement follows a year of negotiations that began at the G-20 Summit in India last year. He also underscored the importance of repatriating illegally acquired ar-

tifacts, which allows communities to reclaim and preserve their heritage. US Ambassador to India, Eric Garcetti, welcomed the agreement, describing it as a vital move to acknowledge and return India's cultural treasures. He pointed out that India

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## DPS Bokaro Alumnus Inspires Students with Life Lessons and Wellness Advice





For a balanced and effective search experience, the relationship between technology and content must be symbiotic, with a strong focus on provenance." OpenAI's CEO, Sam Altman, shared his vision on X (formerly Twitter), stating, "We believe there is significant potential to improve search beyond current capabilities."

## Cobra and CRPF Soldiers Battle Malaria During Naxalite Operations in Saranda

**RNS I Gua:** Cobra and CRPF soldiers stationed in Saranda forest are confronting dual challenges: combating CPI Maoist Naxalites and battling a severe malaria outbreak. On July 25, four CRPF soldiers, including a Deputy Commandant from the Cobra battalion, fell ill with malaria while engaged in operations against Naxalites. They have been hospitalized at Cell Hospital Kiriburur, where Dr. P.R. Singh and his team are providing medical treatment. The malaria outbreak has been exacerbated by the rainy season, significantly increasing mosquito infestation in the dense Saranda forest. Soldiers involved in operations face constant health risks due to the high prevalence of malaria-carrying mosquitoes. Despite their extensive training and readiness to handle various challenges, protecting themselves from malaria remains a significant struggle. Saranda, known for its high malaria incidence, poses additional difficulties as soldiers conduct operations through thick undergrowth, striving to clear the area of Naxalites and restore peace. Mosquito nets are impractical in the field, further complicating efforts to maintain soldier health amidst ongoing operations.

The state government further explained that the directive was issued in response to complaints received from Kanwariyas regarding confusion caused by the names of the shops and eateries. "The yatra is an arduous journey, where some Kanwariyas, i.e. the Dak Kanwariyas, do not even stop to rest once the Kanwar is on their shoulders. There are sacred features of the

pilgrimage, such as the fact that the Kanwar, once filled with holy Gangajal, is not to be kept on the ground; nor under the shadow of the gular tree. It may also be noted that a Kanwaria embarks on the Yatra after years of preparation," the government said in its statement. The Kanwar Yatra, an annual pilgrimage where devotees of Lord Shiva, known as Kanwariyas, travel to fetch holy water from the Ganges River, sees millions of participants each year. The Uttar Pradesh government claimed that the directive was introduced in response to specific complaints from Kanwariyas. Pilgrims had allegedly raised concerns about the food being served along the route, which led to apprehensions regarding its preparation in line with religious practices.

## On Kargil Vijay Diwas, PM Modi defends Agnipath scheme, Congress hits back

PM Modi, speaking at the Kargil War Memorial on Vijay Diwas, said the Agnipath scheme was aimed at rejuvenating the armed forces.

**New Delhi.** Amid demands from the opposition and some NDA allies for a review of the Agnipath scheme, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday mounted a strong defence of the military recruitment policy, saying it aimed to rejuvenate the armed forces and keep them continuously fit for war. The Congress, however, stuck to its demand of scrapping the scheme introduced in 2022.

Addressing a gathering in Ladakh's Dras on the occasion of the 25th anniversary of Kargil Vijay Diwas, PM Modi accused the opposition of playing politics on a sensitive issue connected to national security.

"Some people are spreading the misconception that the government has brought this scheme to save pension money. The question of pension for today's recruits will arise after 30 years. Why would the government take a decision on it today? It should have left it to the governments of that time. We have respected this decision taken by the armed forces because we work for 'rashtreeneeti', not 'rajneeti'," PM Modi said. Under the Agnipath scheme, personnel are recruited

in the Army, Navy and the Air Force on a short-term contract of four years. Of the total annual recruits, only 25% are allowed to continue for another 15 years

under permanent commission. In fact, an internal report of the BJP has cited anger towards the Agnipath scheme as one of the reasons behind the party's debacle in the Uttar Pradesh Lok Sabha polls. In an indirect dig at the Congress, the Prime Minister said the previous governments never cared about the soldiers and also "lied" about the One Rank One Pension scheme.

"It is our government that implemented One Rank One Pension, gave more than Rs 1.25 lakh crore to ex-servicemen. These are the same people who did not build a war memorial... These are the same people who did not provide adequate bulletproof jackets to our soldiers deployed on the border," he asserted.

Countering PM Modi, Congress MP Karti Chidambaram said the scheme in "no way" strengthens the capacity and the capability of the armed forces.

"Agnipath scheme is a short-term induction into the armed forces without the necessary training and the benefits. A professional army going forward needs comprehensive training and a full commission," he said.

### 50 pilgrims stranded in Uttarakhand after heavy rain triggers landslides

**Dehradun.** At least 50 pilgrims and locals were stranded near the Madmaheshwar Temple in Uttarakhand after the yatra to the shrine was stopped on Thursday due to heavy rain and landslides on the trekking route.

According to officials, a temporary wooden bridge, built over the Markanda River, was washed away amid incessant rainfall in the area, disrupting the yatra to the temple even more. The shrine, which is part of the Panch Kedar group of temples in Uttarakhand, is located at an altitude of 11,473 feet. Meanwhile, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) on Thursday issued an 'orange alert' for Dehradun and Bageshwar, predicting moderate to heavy rainfall in the area.

After the advisory, the local administration decided to close all schools and Anganwadi centres in the city for Friday (July 26).

"All government and private schools from class 1 to 12 and Anganwadi centres in Dehradun will remain closed on Friday in view of an 'orange' alert issued by the NDMA's National Disaster Alert Portal for heavy rain accompanied by thunderstorms and lightning in the district," an order by the Dehradun DM said.

### Why Bengal BJP chief's north Bengal-Northeast merger plan has hit a raw nerve

**Kolkata.** Bengal BJP president Dr Sukanta Majumdar's request to the Centre to "include" the northern part of West Bengal with the "North East" has sent shock waves within political circles in West Bengal. Historically, there has been a perception among residents in north Bengal that the region has been neglected in terms of development and infrastructure compared to Kolkata and adjoining areas in the southern part of the state. Majumdar's request is being seen as reinforcing that very sentiment.

"I have handed over a presentation to the Prime Minister highlighting the similarities between north Bengal and the North East and how north Bengal can be included into the Northeast," Majumdar said. "In the future, if north Bengal can be included with the Northeast as part of West Bengal, then the region will get more funds as part of various central schemes. The area is backward and it will help develop the region. I don't think the state government will have any objections and that they will also cooperate," Majumdar, who is also the MoS for Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region, said after a meeting with PM Modi. The development is being seen by some as Majumdar trying to consolidate the BJP's core support in the state, one that has given electoral dividends to the party.

## INDIA protest on July 30 over Arvind Kejriwal's 'declining health' in jail

The Aam Aadmi Party has said that the Opposition-led INDIA bloc will hold a protest at Delhi's Jantar Mantar on July 30 over the declining health of Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal in jail.

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**New Delhi.** The Opposition-led INDIA bloc will hold a rally on July 30 at Delhi's Jantar Mantar to raise the issue of Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's declining health inside Tihar Jail, the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) said on Thursday. The AAP chief is currently lodged in jail in the now-scrapped liquor policy case. The AAP has been accusing the BJP of "conspiring to kill" Kejriwal in jail, citing his medical report to show that his sugar levels had fallen 26 times between June 3 and July 7. "The INDIA bloc will hold a big

rally at Jantar Mantar on July 30 to raise the issue of Kejriwal's falling health," the AAP said.

The ruling party in Delhi has accused the BJP-led Centre and Lieutenant Governor VK Saxena of playing the Chief Minister's life. During a press conference on Thursday, Delhi Minister Atishi was asked about the rally and she said that the BJP was conspiring against the people of the national

capital. "The Bharatiya Janata Party is conspiring against the people of Delhi in every way. It is stopping the work of the people of Delhi.

It is stopping the money of the people of Delhi. The BJP got Arvind Kejriwal, Manish Sisodia and Satyendar Jain who worked for the people of Delhi arrested," she alleged. Atishi also claimed that when the BJP learnt about Kejriwal's possibility to get bail from the Supreme Court, they got him arrested by the CBI. "They know that Kejriwal has diabetes for the last 30 years. His

weight has gone down by 8.5 kg in custody. A glucometer monitors his sugar levels during the entire day. The data of this device is shared with LG and the Centre. They know that Kejriwal's sugar levels have declined to dangerous levels," the Delhi Minister claimed. She alleged that Arvind Kejriwal's sugar levels have dipped a total of 34 times in custody. "BJP knew this and got him arrested by CBI. (The) BJP wants his health to be permanently damaged. All the INDIA bloc parties will protest against Kejriwal's custody and the prevailing danger to his health," Atishi said. Last week, VK Saxena wrote to the Delhi Chief Secretary underscoring Kejriwal's health condition, saying reports provided by the Tihar Jail superintendent flagged that the Chief Minister was intentionally consuming fewer calories than medically recommended. The Lt Governor sought urgent action and implementation of strict protocols for monitoring Kejriwal's blood sugar levels.

A day later, AAP Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Singh claimed that Kejriwal's medical reports showed that "anything can happen to him anytime".

Arvind Kejriwal is lodged at Delhi's Tihar Jail after being arrested by the CBI in a corruption case related to the Delhi liquor policy scam.

Team of five leaders appointed to select candidates

MNS leader cites no consensus between Mahayuti

**Mumbai.** After the recent debacle of the Mahayuti alliance in the Lok Sabha polls, Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS) Chief Raj Thackeray has decided to go solo in the upcoming Assembly elections. At a party meeting held on Thursday in Mumbai, Raj Thackeray said the party was preparing to field candidates in 225-250 seats. Interestingly, just months ago, Thackeray had extended unconditional support to Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the NDA in the Lok Sabha elections. "We are preparing for nearly 225 to 250 seats out of a total of 288 assembly seats in the state," Thackeray said in his address. Raj Thackeray has also appointed a team of five leaders in each constituency to identify probable candidates from his party. Additionally, he will start his Maharashtra tour on August 1 to address meetings and



gather feedback from party workers. On the party's decision to contest alone, MNS leader Sandip Deshpande said they cannot wait for a proposal from the Mahayuti alliance. "There does not seem to be a consensus between the constituent parties (BJP, Shiv Sena Shinde camp, and NCP Ajit Pawar camp) on seat sharing yet," said Deshpande. However, opposition parties pounced on the MNS for changing its political stance.

Anand Dubey, spokesperson of Sena (UBT), said, "Raj Thackeray supported the NDA in Lok Sabha and is now going solo in Vidhan Sabha. He is willing to come to power on his own, despite having only one MLA. He seems to be confused and needs to clarify what he really wants to say." Meanwhile, Sanjay Shirsat, MLA and spokesperson of Shinde's Shiv Sena, asked the MNS to join the Mahayuti alliance for the Assembly polls. "Seat sharing distribution has not yet been finalised. Once the senior party leaders make a final decision on the seat distribution, they will also propose an offer to MNS," he said. Interestingly, Deputy Chief Minister and NCP chief Ajit Pawar has expressed his desire to contest the upcoming state polls on 80 to 90 seats, while Shinde's Sena is eyeing nearly 100 seats.

## Biden out, but Trump may still win

US President Joe Biden announced on July 21 that he was dropping out of the presidential elections due in November. After his poor showing in the one-to-one TV debate with Donald Trump on June 27, there had been a rising crescendo of influential voices in the Democratic Party calling upon Biden to stand down as a candidate and allow a younger nominee to face Trump, the Republican candidate, in the elections. It has taken a precious three weeks since the debate for Biden to yield to pressure from within his party to finally stand down. There will be limited time available for party managers to home in on a credible candidate for endorsement at the Democratic Party convention scheduled to start on August 19. Although Biden has endorsed Vice-President Kamala Harris as the candidate he supports and has urged the party to rally behind her, there are indications that key figures like former President Barack Obama and former House Speaker Nancy Pelosi may prefer another candidate. Any contestation at this late stage can only diminish any raised hopes which may have been generated by Biden's announcement. Assuming Harris does get the party's endorsement at the party convention next month, how do her chances stack up against Trump? Harris has both Black and Asian credentials and should be able to mobilise the non-White constituency. She is a strong champion of women's rights and has been vocal in opposing anti-abortion laws. As a potential first woman President of the US, she may appeal to the large female constituency across the racial divide. She has taken a strong position on the Gaza war, calling for an immediate ceasefire, which contrasts with Biden's continuing though reluctant support to Israel. This may be a nuanced difference with her boss but may make her more congenial to the pro-Palestinian Arab-Americans and a large section of the US youth. While these may be her assets, the downside would be the very limited time she has to mobilise support for her candidacy within the party in the less than four weeks available to her. She cannot afford to have a contested candidacy at the party convention. A quick and consensus endorsement by the party immediately in advance of the convention will free her to concentrate on campaigning against Trump rather than her possible contenders within the party. Even if she wins a contested candidacy at the party convention, legitimacy as a presidential contender will be contrasted with the overwhelming endorsement Trump has already received as the Republican nominee. And Trump would already have a head start in the campaign much before Harris gets her act together. Campaign finance may also be an issue. Some large contributors to the Democratic Party had held back on their contributions after Biden's poor showing at the June debate with Trump. Will they open their purse strings for Harris? There are many doubts on this score. Trump has no problem at all on the finance front. Taking all these factors into account, Biden stepping down and Harris being inducted into the race at this late stage is unlikely to improve the Democrats' chances significantly. If not Harris, who? None of the possible contenders has the name recognition that Harris has and would have even less time to pose a serious and credible challenge to Trump. The best bet for the party is Harris, but a lack of a broad consensus over her candidature will diminish any positive outcome from Biden's exit from the race. Trump has a solid base of support, perhaps as much as 40 per cent of the voting population. The assassination attempt against him has given him the benefit of the inevitable sympathy factor. But more than that, his close brush with death is likely to galvanise his supporters to come out in large numbers to vote for him. There is no comparable galvanising factor on the Democratic side. Enthusiasm among Democratic supporters may be of a lesser order. At this stage of the political game, therefore, Trump appears to have a head start over any Democratic rival. It is likely that Trump will heighten US contention with China, and not only on the trade issue. He has said that he will end the Ukraine war but not how. The large financial and military support the US has extended to Ukraine might be more easily suspended or significantly reduced. The European countries are unlikely to be able to make up for reduced US support.

## Seeing through a satsang and a spectacular wedding

Decadence manifests itself in the naked and vulgar display of wealth, power and privilege.

EVEN though the government stimulates us to dream of 'Viksit Bharat', the fact is that there is no end to our cultural and moral decadence. The prevalent state of our culture cannot be confused with typical calendar art — say, a set of pictures/images of Kabir, Guru Nanak, Gandhi, Tagore and Vivekananda, and select quotes from their noble speeches, sermons and writings. Instead, if culture is the way we actually live, think, behave, act and choose our role models, we need to see its manifestations not in the museumised artefacts but in everyday practices like, to take two recent illustrations, a satsang and a lavish wedding ceremony.

If the 'developed' West — tormented by the contradictions of techno-capitalism and associated 'burnout' culture — has given birth to the entire industry of 'self-help' books, life coaches and motivational speakers to promote some sort of illusory psychic healing, we in India are never tired of producing all sorts of babas and gurus selling their 'miracles' and 'salvation' techniques. Yes, the English-speaking/affluent/metropolitan class living with the anxieties associated with 'productivity' and 'success' prefers fancy gurus, consumes the attractively designed package of Zen, Vedanta and mindfulness, and feels 'relaxed' and 'peaceful' in special 'retreats'. These gurus, almost like Euro-American motivational speakers, do a fairly good business, and make their rich clients — business tycoons, corporate elites, and cricket/Bollywood celebrities — feel 'good' and 'positive'. Live with power, wealth and privilege, but take care of your breathing exercises! What else do the rich need from their gurus? And the poor, the downtrodden and the economically/socially marginalised class — tormented by all sorts of insecurities and everyday struggle for survival — can't approach these celebrity gurus. However, the market manufactures yet another kind of babas for them. And these babas — gross, yet clever and manipulative — begin to play with the existential uncertainty and economic insecurity of the poor and the marginalised, and exploit their psychic vulnerability. It is like hypnotising them through their 'miracles' and mantras; it is like making them believe that a darshan of these babas in a satsang, or their very touch can heal all wounds. Well, the roots



of this 'false consciousness' cannot be understood unless we acknowledge what this recklessly violent and exploitative society has failed to provide them — good education that nurtures clear and critical thinking, sustainable and dignified living, medical care and economic security. In fact, the rise of a manipulator like Bhole Baba, or, for that matter, the chaos and the resultant stampede we recently witnessed in the satsang he organised in Hathras, and eventually the death of over 120 devotees — largely poor, Dalit and women — indicate our collective fall: the unholy alliance of these

spectacle to demonstrate what money could do. Yes, money, as the young, idealist, Hegelian Karl Marx wrote in 1844, can transform everything into its opposite: vice into virtue, or ugliness into beauty. It is, therefore, not surprising that this wedding ceremony lost its sublime music; instead, it showed the power the 'billionaire raj' in contemporary India holds over the economy, politics, culture and religion. From the galaxy of corporate elites to the icons of popular culture, and from religious gurus to influential politicians — the Ambanis seem to have mastered the technique of 'holding and possessing' everybody who matters. In a way, the lavish wedding ceremony showed its magical power to unite global capitalism, 'Hindu traditions', culture industry, religion and politics. And as ordinary/unknown Indians, you and I were persuaded to consume the tales of this spectacle — the flow of Rs 5,000 crore, the photo sessions, the fashion parade, the dazzling guest list, the diplomacy beneath the exchange of gifts, the food bonanza... Yes, from a satsang in Hathras to a wedding ceremony in Mumbai — the decadence seems to be all-pervading. See the way everything has become upside down. For the elites, the Gandhian ideal of austerity or minimalism seems to have become a bad word in contemporary India; the nexus between the political class and the corporate elites is the new normal; religion has lost the religiosity of love and compassion as it has become merely an instrument for retaining the status quo; and ordinary citizens have been reduced into a crowd of non-critical/non-reflexive consumers of cricket, Bollywood, soap operas, the 'magical' deeds of babas and gurus, the dramaturgical performances of the political class, and the fairy tales of the galaxy of celebrities. Will it ever be possible to resist this rot and move towards a sane culture — a culture that nurtures the spirit of equity and justice, values simplicity and decency and promotes the kind of critical thinking that enables us to say 'no' to the vulgar display of wealth through which the select billionaires demonstrate their narcissistic selves or the way the entire industry of babas and gurus reduces religion to a business?

merchants of illusory religion and the politico-administrative class. What else is it except our moral/religious/cultural/political decadence? And now think of yet another kind of decadence that manifests itself in the naked and vulgar display of wealth, power and privilege. Almost like a glossy Bollywood film or a TV serial, the wedding ceremony of Anant Ambani and Radhika Merchant looked spectacular and hyper-real. Never mind the gross socioeconomic inequality that characterises our society. Never mind the intensity of hunger, malnutrition and homelessness. And don't expect the ideals like austerity, decency and simplicity from the elite class. Instead, as the mix of market fundamentalism, hyper-consumerism and psychic narcissism becomes the desired ideal in the age of neo-liberalism, the Ambanis found nothing wrong in transforming an otherwise beautiful and sacred occasion like the wedding of their son into a glossy

## Vision for agriculture

Focus on sustainability, income for farmers

THE 2024-25 Budget introduces significant provisions aimed at transforming the agricultural sector with a focus on sustainability, productivity and economic growth for farmers. One crore farmers are envisaged to be initiated into natural farming within two years. This enterprise is to be complemented by establishing 10,000 bio-input resource centres for sustainable farm practices. To enhance vegetable production and streamline the supply chain, the Budget emphasises promoting Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs), cooperatives and startups. Playing a critical role in the collection, storage and marketing of vegetables, these entities will help farmers receive better prices and reduce post-harvest losses.

Another notable initiative is the release of 109 new high-yielding and climate-resilient varieties of 32 field and



horticulture crops. It aims to address climate change challenges and ensure stable agricultural production. A review of the agricultural research setup is also planned. In a bid to reduce the country's dependence on imported

edible oils, the Budget introduces measures to boost the cultivation of mustard, groundnut, sesame, soybean and sunflower. Digital Public Infrastructure (DPI) is set to revolutionise the sector by covering farmers and their lands within three years. However, these ambitious provisions face implementation challenges. The widespread adoption of natural farming practices requires substantial training and support, which may strain resources. Establishing 10,000 bio-input resource centres and enhancing FPOs necessitate better coordination and investment. Promoting climate-resilient crop varieties and boosting oilseed production hinge on robust extension services. DPI initiatives also require overcoming technological barriers and ensuring equitable access. Addressing them is vital for realising the Budget's vision.

## Budget reflects new realities of political landscape

What stands out in the budgetary proposals is the detailed plan outlined for employment and skilling, clearly in response to the clamour for jobs.

THE first Budget of the new government reflects the new realities of the political landscape, even as it seeks to move towards higher and more inclusive growth. Agriculture and employment, along with skilling, have been given pride of place, even as efforts have been made to cool down bullish equity markets. The infrastructure push continues, but the private sector is now clearly expected to shoulder the burden of higher investments. As for the long-suffering salaried middle class, it has finally been given its due with a cut in the standard deduction and reduced tax rates. Stock markets may be unhappy with some levies, but the abolition of the angel tax and corporate tax cuts on foreign companies are set to give an impetus to investments. Despite these cuts, fiscal prudence remains a major achievement, with the deficit being brought down from 5.1 per cent in the Interim Budget to 4.9 for 2024-25.

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman's seventh Budget looks to the future. But the next-generation reforms have been set aside for a new economic policy framework. Though some steps are proposed in the critical area of land reforms, with the digitisation of rural and urban land records, others have been left to await the unveiling of this new policy. Medium and small industries must also wait until more detailed proposals are formulated to get rid of the licensing and compliance rules that have been a huge burden for the sector.

On agriculture, the focus is rightly on research in the areas of productivity and climate change, as experts agree that it is time for this sector to pivot in a new direction. Decades after the Green Revolution, which brought prosperity and plenty in foodgrains, the agriculture economy now has to move towards other crops and improved efficiency. Vegetables, oilseeds and pulses are thus given higher priority in the

Budget along with marine products like shrimp, which dominate the export basket. What stands out in the budgetary proposals, however, is the detailed plan outlined for employment and skilling, clearly in response to the clamour for jobs, which was a dominant theme in the elections. The proposals envisage employment subsidies in the formal sector, for which Rs 1.48 lakh crore has been allocated in the current fiscal. From providing the first month's salary to the support in provident fund deductions, the set of schemes is expected to benefit 29 million youth in new jobs. The onus is also on business houses to ensure that some funding is provided through their corporate social responsibility corpus.

Skilling has not been left out either, and a new Centrally sponsored scheme for this purpose will upgrade Industrial Training Institutes in line with the industry's needs. It is expected to benefit two million young people. The only snag is that, so far, such skilling education has not been effective enough to meet the needs of many sectors. There is, thus, the incongruent situation of jobs being available but not enough trained personnel to fill them. A more nuanced approach needs to be taken to such skilling programmes by involving leading agencies so that the end result is an employable individual.

The need to push up female labour force participation is mentioned in the form of a public-private partnership in setting up women's hostels and crèches. But details of the proposal are yet to be given. Other schemes are also specified for promoting greater market access for women-led cooperative enterprises. But there needs to be much greater emphasis on providing support to women to enter the labour force in a deeply patriarchal society. The other element in the Budget that is clearly the



outcome of political compulsions facing a coalition government is the largesse being showered on the states of Bihar and Andhra Pradesh. The new Purvodaya scheme for the eastern region, however, will probably provide a long-awaited thrust to infrastructure in the slowest-growing region of the country. Significantly, the funding is being provided not just from the Centre but through multilateral financing institutions. Andhra Pradesh is an outlier in the eastern region in terms of economic development. Even so, it needs a massive infusion of funds, both for the new capital and the critical Polavaram Irrigation Project. Here, too, there will be a mix of funding from the Centre and multilateral institutions. But a clear signal of reassurance has gone out to the key coalition partners, Nitish Kumar and Chandrababu Naidu, that finance will be provided for essential infrastructure in both states. It

is in the area of taxation, however, that the Budget proposals have likely given the most joy and the most grief to different segments. The increase in the standard reduction as well as the alteration of personal income tax rates are bound to please the salaried middle class. The catch is that taxpayers will have to opt for the new tax regime without any exemption to avail themselves of the new rates. Yet, it was a long-awaited change, and Sitharaman had the fiscal space this year to finally fulfil the expectations of the salaried segment. Foreign companies have also been given a cut in the corporate tax rate from 40 to 35 per cent. It could conceivably reverse the declining trend in foreign direct investment. The removal of the angel tax will similarly be greeted by hosannas from the startup community, as it was aimed at fledgling companies in this segment.

As for the increase in the short- and long-term capital gains tax as well as the hiking of the securities transaction tax on futures and options trading, the stock markets had a gloomy reaction. They traded in the red for the whole day, evidently in the fallout from the tax hikes. The first Budget of Modi 3.0 is thus marked by pragmatism rather than populism. The exchequer had the benefit of an infusion of funds from the RBI earlier in the year, allowing fiscal prudence along with a continued push in public capital expenditure. Yet, the launch of the badly needed next-generation reforms, especially in case of doing business, is still awaited, as these will generate a major stimulus to the economy.

एजेसी नई दिल्ली। घरेलू शेयर बाजार के बैचमार्क इंडेक्स सेंसेक्स और निफ्टी आज लगातार पांचवें कारोबारी दिन गिरावट के साथ बंद हुए। आज के कारोबार की शुरुआत भी गिरावट के साथ हुई थी। बाजार खुलते ही बिकवाली के दबाव की वजह से शेयर बाजार की गिरावट थोड़ी और बढ़ गई लेकिन पहले आधे घंटे के कारोबार में ही खरीदारों ने लिवाली का जोर बना दिया। इसकी वजह से सेंसेक्स और निफ्टी दोनों सूचकांकों ने निचले स्तर से रिकवरी शुरू कर दी। पूरे दिन के कारोबार के बाद सेंसेक्स 0.14 प्रतिशत और निफ्टी 0.03 प्रतिशत की कमजोरी के साथ बंद हुए। आज के कारोबार के दौरान ऑयल एंड गैस, कैपिटल गूड्स, ऑटोमोबाइल, पावर और एनर्जी सेक्टर के शेयरों में जम कर खरीदारी होती रही। इसी तरह हेल्थ केयर और मीडिया इंडेक्स भी बढ़ते के साथ बंद हुए। दूसरी ओर मेटल, एयरस्पेस, टेलीकॉम, रियल्टी और बैंकिंग सेक्टर के शेयरों में बिकवाली का दबाव बना रहा। ब्राडमार्केट में भी आज आमतौर पर बिकवाली का दबाव बना रहा,

जिसके कारण बीएसई का मिडकैप इंडेक्स 0.22 प्रतिशत की कमजोरी के साथ बंद हुआ। इसी तरह स्मॉलकैप इंडेक्स ने 0.14 प्रतिशत टूट कर आज के कारोबार का अंत किया। आज बाजार में आई गिरावट के बावजूद घरेलू संस्थान निवेशकों द्वारा आक्रामक तरीके से खरीदारी करने के कारण स्टॉक मार्केट के निवेशक ओवरऑल फायदे में रहे। बीएसई में लिस्टेड कंपनियों का मार्केट कैपिटलाइजेशन आज के कारोबार के बाद बढ़ कर 450.27 लाख करोड़ रुपये (अस्थायी) हो गया जबकि पिछले कारोबारी दिन यानी बुधवार को इनका मार्केट कैपिटलाइजेशन 449.47 लाख करोड़ रुपये था। इस तरह निवेशकों को आज के कारोबार से करीब 80 हजार करोड़ रुपये का मुनाफा हो गया। आज दिनभर के कारोबार में बीएसई में 4,023 शेयरों में एक्टिव ट्रेडिंग हुई। इनमें 2,118 शेयर बढ़ते के साथ बंद हुए, जबकि 1,795 शेयरों में गिरावट का रुख रहा, वहीं 110 शेयर बिना किसी उतार चढ़ाव के बंद हुए। एनएसई में आज 2,351 शेयरों में एक्टिव ट्रेडिंग हुई। इनमें से 1,138 शेयर मुनाफा

कमा कर रहे निशान में और 1,213 शेयर नुकसान उठा कर लाल निशान में बंद हुए। इसी तरह सेंसेक्स में शामिल 30 शेयरों में से 13 शेयर बढ़ते के साथ और 17 शेयर गिरावट के साथ बंद हुए जबकि निफ्टी में शामिल 50 शेयरों में से 22 शेयर हरे निशान में और 28 शेयर लाल निशान में बंद हुए। बीएसई का सेंसेक्स आज 606.77 अंक की कमजोरी के साथ 79,542.11 अंक के स्तर पर खुला। कारोबार की शुरुआत होते ही बिकवाली का दबाव बढ़ जाने के कारण ये सूचकांक लुढ़क कर 79,477.83 अंक तक पहुंच गया लेकिन इसके बाद बाजार में खरीदार एक्टिव हो गए। इसकी वजह से इस सूचकांक की चाल में सुधार होने लगा। बाजार में लगातार हो रही खरीदारी के कारण दोपहर 2 बजे के करीब ये सूचकांक उछल कर 80,143.10 अंक तक पहुंच गया लेकिन इसके बाद एक बार फिर बिकवाली शुरू हो जाने की वजह से इस सूचकांक में गिरावट आ गई। पूरे दिन के कारोबार के बाद सेंसेक्स 109.08 अंक की गिरावट के साथ 80,039.80 अंक के स्तर पर बंद हुआ।

एजेसी नई दिल्ली। वित्त मंत्रालय के राजस्व सचिव संजय मल्होत्रा ने कहा कि केंद्र सरकार प्रत्यक्ष कर संहिता की व्यापक समीक्षा की दिशा में काम कर रही है। इसके आंतरिक समिति के द्वारा तैयार किया जाएगा, फिर अगले छह महीनों के भीतर हितधारकों के परामर्श के लिए साझा किया जाएगा। संजय मल्होत्रा ने यहां केंद्रीय बजट 2024-25 पर भारतीय वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग महासंघ (फिक्की) के एक संवादात्मक सत्र को संबोधित करते हुए यह बात कही। उन्होंने कहा कि हमारे पास परामर्श प्रक्रिया होगी और यह कैसे होगा, यह

हम तय करेंगे। राजस्व सचिव ने कहा कि हम कार्यान्वयन के लिए एक सहयोगात्मक दृष्टिकोण अपनाना मुक्त, सरल और सहयोगात्मक दृष्टिकोण अपनाने के लिए प्रयास जारी रखेंगे। उन्होंने कहा कि करारधान के प्रति हमारा दृष्टिकोण हमेशा सहयोग की शैली में रहा है, जो आगे भी रहेगा, टकराव की नहीं। राजस्व सचिव ने कहा कि नीतिगत और क्रियान्वयन दोनों ही दृष्टि से हमारे प्रस्तावों का उद्देश्य हां से भी कर देय है, वहां से कर को एकत्र करना है, लेकिन ऐसा इस तरह से करना है कि करदाताओं को सम्मान और विश्वास मिले तथा कर संग्रह सहज और परेशानी रहित तरीके से हो। केंद्रीय बजट 2024-25 के व्यापक विषयों पर प्रकाश डालते हुए मल्होत्रा ने कहा कि बजट

एजेसी नई दिल्ली। बजट पेश होने के बाद मल्टी कर्मांड्री एक्सचेंज (एमसीएक्स) में सोने और चांदी के भाव में लगातार गिरावट की स्थिति बनी हुई है। इस गिरावट के कारण एमसीएक्स में सोना 4 महीने के सबसे निचले स्तर पर पहुंच गया है। इसी तरह चांदी की कीमत भी 2 महीने के सबसे निचले स्तर पर पहुंच गई है। एमसीएक्स पर वायदा कारोबार में सोना 68,000 रुपये प्रति 10 ग्राम के करीब पहुंच गया है। चांदी की कीमत भी 81,300 रुपये के स्तर पर पहुंच गई है। आंकड़ों के मुताबिक पिछले एक हफ्ते के दौरान ही एमसीएक्स पर सोने के भाव में 7 प्रतिशत की गिरावट आई है। वहीं एक महीने के आंकड़े पर नजर डालें, तो ये गिरावट 5 प्रतिशत की है। ये स्थिति भी तब है, जब अमेरिका में सोने के वायदा कारोबार में पिछले एक हफ्ते में सिर्फ एक प्रतिशत की गिरावट दर्ज की गई है। एक महीने का आंकड़ा देखें तो वायदा कारोबार में अमेरिकी बाजार में सोने के भाव



में 2 प्रतिशत की तेजी आई है। अगर साल 2024 की शुरुआत से लेकर अभी तक का आंकड़ा देखें तो अमेरिकी वायदा बाजार में सोना 15 प्रतिशत तक की गिरावट आई है। एक महीने के आंकड़े में चांदी में 6 प्रतिशत तक की गिरावट दर्ज की गई है। हालांकि, 2024 की शुरुआत से

शुरुआत से लेकर अभी तक अमेरिका के वायदा बाजार में चांदी की कीमत में 17 प्रतिशत तक की तेजी आ चुकी है। भारत में सोने और चांदी की कीमत में आई गिरावट की एक बड़ी वजह बजट में सोने और चांदी पर लगने वाली ड्यूटी में हुई कटौती को माना जा रहा है। जानकारों का मानना है कि इस कटौती की वजह से एमसीएक्स पर 2 दिन के कारोबार में ही सोना और चांदी दोनों के भाव में 4.8 प्रतिशत से लेकर 6 प्रतिशत तक की गिरावट दर्ज की गई है। इसके साथ ही चीन से सोने की मांग में कमी आने की वजह से भी अंतरराष्ट्रीय बाजार में इस चमकीली धातु में कमजोरी आ गई है। कॉमेक्स पर सोना फिलहाल 2,380 डॉलर प्रति औंस से नीचे चला गया है। इसी तरह चांदी की कीमत भी 28 डॉलर प्रति औंस से नीचे गिर गई है। अंतरराष्ट्रीय बाजार में आई इस कमी का असर भी एमसीएक्स में सोना और चांदी के वायदा कारोबार पर पड़ रहा है।

लेकर अभी तक चांदी के भाव में 13 प्रतिशत तक की तेजी दर्ज की जा चुकी है। दूसरी ओर, अमेरिका के वायदा बाजार में चांदी के भाव में पिछले एक हफ्ते के दौरान 4 प्रतिशत की गिरावट दर्ज की गई, जबकि एक महीने के दौरान ये कमजोरी 5 प्रतिशत की रही लेकिन 2024 की

एजेसी नई दिल्ली। क्रिप्टो करेंसी मार्केट में जबरदस्त दबाव बना हुआ है। मार्केट कैप के लिहाज से टॉप-10 में शामिल क्रिप्टो करेंसीज में से 9 गिरावट के साथ रेडजोन में कारोबार कर रही हैं, जबकि सिर्फ यूएसडी कॉइन ही मामूली बढ़त के साथ ग्रीन ज़ोन में कारोबार कर रहा है। बाजार में बने दबाव के कारण दुनिया की सबसे बड़ी क्रिप्टो करेंसी बिटकॉइन 3 प्रतिशत से भी ज्यादा टूट कर 54 लाख रुपये के स्तर से भी नीचे आ गई है। इसी तरह दुनिया की दूसरी सबसे बड़ी क्रिप्टो करेंसी एथेरियम भी पिछले 24 घंटे के दौरान 8 प्रतिशत से ज्यादा गिरावट का शिकार हो गई है। भारत में क्रिप्टो करेंसी का कारोबार करने के लिए अधिकृत एजेसी कॉइन मार्केट कैप से मिली जानकारी के मुताबिक भारतीय समय के हिसाब से आज शाम 6 बजे तक बिटकॉइन 3.50 प्रतिशत की गिरावट के साथ 53.75 लाख रुपये के स्तर

पर कारोबार कर रहा था। इसी तरह एथेरियम की कीमत भी आज 8.49 प्रतिशत की कमजोरी के साथ गिर कर 2.65 लाख रुपये के स्तर पर आ गई थी। बिटकॉइन और एथेरियम के अलावा टेट्र 0.03 प्रतिशत, बीएनबी 3.52 प्रतिशत, सोलाना 5.11 प्रतिशत, एक्सआरपी 3.41 प्रतिशत, डॉगकोइन 7.01 प्रतिशत, टॉनकॉइन 5.38 प्रतिशत और कार्डानो 5.59 प्रतिशत की कमजोरी के साथ कारोबार कर रहे थे। दूसरी

ओर, यूएसडी कॉइन 0.02 प्रतिशत की मामूली बढ़त के साथ कारोबार कर रहा था। कॉइन मार्केट कैप से मिली जानकारी के मुताबिक पिछले 24 घंटे के कारोबार के दौरान क्रिप्टो करेंसी के ग्लोबल मार्केट कैप में 4.48 प्रतिशत की गिरावट दर्ज की गई है। फिलहाल क्रिप्टो करेंसी का ग्लोबल मार्केट कैप घट कर 193.45 लाख करोड़ रुपये रह गया है। ग्लोबल मार्केट कैप में गिरावट के

बावजूद पिछले 24 घंटे के दौरान क्रिप्टो करेंसीज के लेनदेन में तेजी आई है। इस अवधि में कुल 7.09 लाख करोड़ रुपये की क्रिप्टो करेंसी की लेनदेन हुई, जो 1 दिन पहले की तुलना में 8.06 प्रतिशत अधिक है। अगर दुनिया की सबसे बड़ी क्रिप्टो करेंसी बिटकॉइन की बात करें तो मार्केट में गिरावट आने के बावजूद पिछले 24 घंटे के कारोबार के दौरान क्रिप्टो करेंसी मार्केट में इस आभासी मुद्रा की स्थिति 0.62 प्रतिशत मजबूत हुई है, जिसके कारण इसकी मार्केट हिस्सेदारी बढ़ कर 54.87 प्रतिशत हो गई है।

**केनरा बैंक को पहली तिमाही में 3,905 करोड़ रुपये का हुआ मुनाफा**

एजेसी नई दिल्ली। सार्वजनिक क्षेत्र के केनरा बैंक ने चालू वित्त वर्ष 2024-25 की पहली तिमाही (अप्रैल-जून) के नतीजे का ऐलान कर दिया है। अप्रैल-जून तिमाही में बैंक का मुनाफा 10 फीसदी बढ़कर 3,905 करोड़ रुपये पर पहुंच गया

है। पिछले वित्त वर्ष 2023-24 की सामान्य तिमाही में बैंक को 3,535 करोड़ रुपये का शुद्ध लाभ हुआ था। केनरा बैंक ने गुरुवार को शेयर बाजार को दी जानकारी में बताया कि फंसे कर्ज में कमी आने से बैंक का मुनाफा बढ़ा है। बैंक के मुताबिक अप्रैल-जून तिमाही में उसकी कुल



आय बढ़कर 34,020 करोड़ रुपये हो गई, जबकि इससे पिछले वित्त वर्ष की सामान्य तिमाही में यह 29,823 करोड़ रुपये थी। इस दौरान बैंक की ब्याज आय बढ़कर 28,701 करोड़ रुपये हो गई, जो पिछले वित्त वर्ष की इसी तिमाही में 25,004 करोड़ रुपये रही थी।

बैंक के मुताबिक उसकी शुद्ध ब्याज आय छह फीसदी बढ़कर 9,166 करोड़ रुपये हो गई है, जबकि पिछले वित्त वर्ष की इसी तिमाही में यह 8,666 करोड़ रुपये थी। बैंक का शुद्ध ब्याज मार्जिन (एनआईएम) 3.75 प्रतिशत से घटकर 2.90 फीसदी हो गया है।

केनरा बैंक के प्रबंध निदेशक (एमडी) के सत्यनारायण राजू ने कहा कि भविष्य में एनआईएम में सुधार होने की उम्मीद है, जो 2.95 फीसदी पर पहुंच जाएगा। उन्होंने बताया कि निदेशक मंडल ने चालू वित्त वर्ष में 8,500 करोड़ रुपये जुटाने की मंजूरी दी है।


## छवि खराब कर सकती है यह आदत

Paris Olympics 2024: Aditi Ashok's chance to leave Tokyo heartbreak behind

**New Delhi** Aditi Ashok will be one of India's biggest hopes of winning a medal in the upcoming Paris Olympics 2024. Last time around in Tokyo, Ashok agonizingly missed out on finishing on the podium from once being in a position to win a silver medal. She finished fourth. Back in 2016, Ashok gave a glimpse into the future when she made her debut in the Olympics. In the Tokyo Olympics, she came close to winning India's first-ever medal in the Olympics, but fell short. She gave herself a chance to win a medal till the 17th hole when Lydia Ko pulled off a birdie to break the tie and push the Indian golfer down to fourth. Back in June, Ashok booked a ticket to Paris after she was ranked No.41 in the Olympic Golf Rankings (OGR). The youngster will be seen in action when the women's individual event takes place from August 7 to 10 and has a great chance of making amends. Whether or not she gets a medal will only be known on August 10 when the Women's Individual Stroke Play Round 4 takes place. Along with Ashok, Diksha Dagar is the only other female golfer in the Paris Olympics. She also broke into the Indian squad after being ranked No.41 in the world.

Gaganjeet, Shubhankar set for Olympic debuts Gaganjeet Bhullar, Shubhankar Sharma form the men's contingent along with Diksha and Ashok as the quartet looks to end India's long wait for an Olympic medal in golf. Shubhankar, ranked 48th in the men's OGR list, and Gaganjeet, ranked 54th, secured Olympic quotas and will also be making their debuts in the quadrennial event.

The duo came up the ranks after the Indian Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports helped them out through the Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS). The 27-year-old Shubhankar is a two-time winner on the European Tour and was also Asia's No.1 player back in 2018. Bhullar, on the other hand, is an 11-time Asian Tour champion and a 2006 Asian Games silver medal winner.

The golf events at the Paris Olympics will take place at Le Golf National, starting on August 1, with 60 men's and 60 women's golfers participating. The men's event will take place from August 1 to 4.

England's Ben Stokes wants cramped international schedule to be addressed

**New Delhi.** England captain Ben Stokes has voiced concerns over the current international cricket schedule, emphasizing the need for it to be "addressed" and advocating for player input on future tour programs. Following the final Test against West Indies at Edgbaston, England will enjoy a three-week break for The Hundred tournament before facing Sri Lanka in a three-match series. This will be the longest rest period for England players until the end of the year. The Sri Lanka Test series concludes on September 10, and Australia's white-ball team begins an eight-match tour just a day later at the Ageas Bowl. From there, England's schedule became relentless, with the Australia series immediately followed by a Test tour to Pakistan, a white-ball series in the West Indies, and three Tests in New Zealand to close out the year. This tight schedule particularly impacts players who compete in all three formats, leaving little time for rest and recovery between series. When asked if his ambitions with the Test team would be hampered by the schedule, Stokes replied, "I hope not. It is something that does need to be addressed. Who knows what international cricket is going to look like, with all the franchise stuff that is going on as well? It does need to get looked at. The landscape is constantly changing. I don't think anyone can put their hand on their heart and say they know what cricket is going to look like in even two years' time." Stokes suggested that consultation with players, including himself and Jos Buttler, could provide valuable input on the Future Tours Programme (FTP). "The FTP could maybe see the people playing in it consulted, and I think we could have some good input in that," he said. When asked whether he had been consulted on the recent FTP running from 2023-27, Stokes responded, "Yes and no. Make of that what you will."

With Sat-Chi at helm, India readies for best-ever badminton show in Paris

**New Delhi.** In an exclusive interaction with IndiaToday.in, Badminton Association of India general secretary Sanjay Mishra said that he was expecting two to three medals from badminton in the Paris Olympics. It was a bold call given India have won just 3 medals in the sport in the entire history of the competition. Out of the three, two medals were won in 2016 and 2020, where PV Sindhu finished second and third respectively. However, there might be some merit to the logic.

The 7-member contingent for India is their strongest ever and consists of world beaters. India's best singles player, HS Prannoy, world no. 3 doubles pairing Satwiksairaj Rankireddy-Chirag Shetty, and the unpredictable Lakshya Sen, are part of the men's team. India's most consistent big game player - PV Sindhu, will be at the helm of the women's contingent alongside Ashwini Ponnappa and Tanisha Crasto.

The sport has grown by leaps and bounds in the country since the Thomas Cup 2022 win and has helped in the recognition of the players as well. The BAI general secretary revealed that the association has tried to increase cash rewards for the athletes, apart from giving them better facilities for training.

# Olympics 2024: Indian shooters aim to end 12-year drought in Paris

**India will enter the Paris Olympics with their largest ever shooting contingent featuring 21 athletes who will be eager to end the country's 12-year-long medal drought in the sport at the mega event.**

**New Delhi.** The quest for medals has begun at the Paris Olympics 2024 as players from different nations have started competing at the sporting extravaganza. India have also sent a 117-member strong contingent for the quadrennial event out of which 21 will be seen competing in shooting.

Notably, India have won four medals in shooting in their Olympic history making it their third most successful sport at the mega event. The foundation of India's successful run in shooting in three consecutive

Olympic events was laid when Rajyavardhan Singh Rathore won a historic silver medal at the 2004 Athens Olympics.

The Jaipur-born athlete secured a silver medal in double-trap event making him the first individual Olympic silver medal winner from India post-independence. Post Rajyavardhan's heroics, Abhinav Bindra took the Indian shooting to unprecedented heights in the next edition held in Beijing as he struck gold in 10m air rifle.

As a result, he etched his name in Indian sporting history with golden words being the first individual gold medal winner in Olympics from the country. Indian shooters continued podium finishes in the 2012 London Olympics as well with Gagan Narang bagging a bronze in 10m air rifle while Vijay Kumar secured a silver in 25m rapid fire pistol. However, since then two editions have passed for India without a single Olympic medal in shooting.

India's largest-ever shooting contingent Hence, the Indian shooting



contingent will be desperate to end the drought in the upcoming event as they enter the tournament with their largest group ever. The 21-member team surpasses their 15-member squad from Tokyo 2020.

The Indian shooters will be seen participating in all the 15 events at the Paris Olympics. The contingent will be led by former world Olympic Champions Manu Baker who will compete in women's 10m air pistol, 25m

pistol and 10m air pistol mixed team.

The contingent also features Aishwary Pratap Singh Tomar, Anjum Moudgil and Elavenil Valarivan from the Tokyo Olympics while the remaining will be making their debut at the mega event.

Shooting events to begin from July 27.

One of the emerging talents in the Indian shooting fraternity is Sift Kaur Samra who bagged a gold at the 2023 Hangzhou Asian Games in the women's 50m rifle 3 positions. Another notable performer from India is 19-year-old shooter Esha Singh who also clinched four medals in Asian Games. On the other hand, Sarabjot Singh and Arjun Singh Cheema will feature in 10m air pistol Indian team while Anant Jeet Singh Naruka will feature in skeet shotgun events.

The shooting event at Paris 2024 begins with 10m air rifle competition on July 27 and will come to a close with the skeet mixed team gold medal match on August 5.

## Jasprit Bumrah on Hardik getting booed during IPL 2024: It changed after WC

**New Delhi.** India's premier fast bowler Jasprit Bumrah opened up about how Hardik Pandya dealt after getting booed during the IPL 2024. Hardik had dealt with immense criticism and slandering when he replaced Rohit Sharma as the captain of the MI franchise during IPL 2024. Bumrah revealed that despite the time of adversity, Hardik's mental resilience was key. However, Hardik turned his boos to cheers within a month after he helped India lift the T20 World Cup 2024 at Barbados on June 29, Saturday. Hardik Pandya was booed across the stadiums during the IPL 2024 and had to face scrutiny from the fans. Hardik left GT to return to MI after 2 years and his comeback did not go down well with the supporters. From Ahmedabad to Wankhede, Hardik was booed by the fans and the all-rounder chose not to take it on his heart and continued playing and captaining the team with focus. However, Mumbai had an abysmal run in the tournament as they finished in 10th position in the points table with just four wins from 14 matches.

**Bumrah reflects on Hardik's struggles** Bumrah acknowledged that the emotions of



the fans are attached to the sport in the country. We understand (that) we live in a country where emotion is really the talking point. It's an emotion-driven country. We understand that fans do get emotional, and players are also emotional," Bumrah said in an interview with Jasprit Bumrah.

He further emphasized on facing difficulty in blocking out the negative comments and the boos, despite the necessity to do so.

"It does affect that you're an India player, and you're playing in India, and your own fans are speaking that about you. But it is the way it is. You've got to take it on your chin. How can you go out there and stop people?"

"If you start focussing on yourself, you try to

shut that door," Bumrah said. "It's not that simple saying 'just don't focus on it.' They're screaming, and you can hear it, but then, the inner circle helps you. We, as a team, don't encourage that, we don't promote that, we don't think that is warranted."

The fast bowler highlighted the importance of having the support of teammates and families during times like these.

"Now, the world can think what they want to. We as a team were talking to him, if he needed support, his family would always be there. Certain things are beyond your control. If it happens, it happens."

**Hardik scripts his redemption** He also suggested that the perception of the fans for Hardik changed after his heroics in the T20 World Cup 2024. He also cautioned that this narrative could change quickly with just one loss. "Now, that narrative has changed since we won the World Cup." You cannot take it seriously. Because, again, the people are singing praises. It doesn't mean it's the be-all and the end-all. A few days later, if we lose another game, the narrative can change. You understand it is how it is.

## India captain Suryakumar reveals special relationship with coach Gambhir

**India's newly appointed T20I captain Suryakumar Yadav shares insights on his relationship with head coach Gautam Gambhir as they prepare for the upcoming series against Sri Lanka.**

**New Delhi.** India's newly appointed T20I captain Suryakumar Yadav has opened up on his special relationship with head coach Gautam Gambhir ahead of the limited-overs series against Sri Lanka. This series marks the beginning of a new era under head coach Gambhir, who recently took over from Rahul Dravid following India's T20 World Cup triumph. One of Gambhir's



significant early decisions was appointing Suryakumar as the T20I captain, replacing Hardik Pandya. This choice sparked considerable discussion, but as the series opener approaches, the focus is now on the present and the future. "Yeh jo relationship hai, bahut special hai. Reflecting on their experiences with the Kolkata Knight Riders, Surya noted how this dynamic would benefit the Indian team in their new roles. "But he knows ki main kaise kaam karta hoon. What my mindset is when I come to practice sessions. How he tries to work as a coach. And it's all about that lovely relationship we have and very excited to see how it goes forward," Suryakumar concluded. Gambhir's tenure as head coach and Suryakumar's captaincy promise a fresh approach, aiming to build on India's recent successes and take the team to new heights.

## Paris to kick off 2024 Olympics under tight security

**France will host a grand Olympic opening ceremony in Paris on Friday, featuring a parade along the Seine amidst tight security. The event occurs against a backdrop of global tensions and heightened security measures.**

**New Delhi.** France aims to wow the world on Friday with an extravagant Olympics opening ceremony through the heart of Paris, officially kicking off Games fraught with security risks at a time of heightened geopolitical tensions. Some 45,000 police, 10,000 soldiers and 2,000 private security staff will ensure the safety of the parade along the river Seine, its banks and surrounding monuments, in an unprecedented display of security. A

procession of barges will take nearly 7,000 athletes along the river past Paris's most famous landmarks, while more than 300,000 spectators will watch from the banks. Since the last Olympics in Beijing in 2022, wars have erupted in Ukraine and Gaza, providing a tense backdrop to the Games. France is at its highest level of security - though officials have repeatedly said there is no specific threat to the opening ceremony or the Games.

As part of a vast security operation, authorities have turned to powers passed under an anti-terror law, placing 155 people under surveillance measures that strictly limit their movement, according to official data and a Reuters review of cases. Meanwhile, Israeli competitors are being escorted by elite tactical units to and from events and given 24-hour protection throughout the Olympics, officials say.

**Paris Olympics 2024: Full Coverage** Scores of world leaders will be in Paris for the opening ceremony, which will be protected by snipers on rooftops. The Seine's riverbed has been swept for bombs, and Paris'



airspace will be closed. For the Games more generally, radar-surveillance planes and Reaper drones will watch sensitive sites from above, and Mirage 2000 fighter jets will be on standby to intercept aircraft straying into restricted airspace.

**EVERYTHING READY** "Everything is ready," French President Emmanuel Macron said in a video he posted on X. "Even the (Olympics) rings are there," he said, overlooking the Eiffel tower. "Enjoy the Games!" Macron, who won a second mandate two years ago, had hoped the

Olympics would cement his legacy. But his failed bet on a snap legislative election has weakened him and is casting a shadow over his moment on the international stage. High security also means much grumbling from locals, after police imposed a security zone along the river ahead of the opening ceremony, erecting metal barriers to fence off neighbourhoods and requiring authorisation - passes with QR codes - to enter. Cafes along the banks of the Seine, which normally buzz with activity in the summer, have been left very quiet due to the restrictions. That has not helped lift the national mood over the Olympics, which Macron will hope improves once the Games have properly started. Russia's invasion of Ukraine means Moscow's usually huge delegation of athletes has been reduced to 15 who met and accepted eligibility requirements to compete as neutrals, according to a list published by the IOC on July 20.
